## **Article 1 – Announcement**

West Cumbria Motorsport Club Ltd will organise the 2020 Eddie Shimmings Ltd Rally Test Championship. The championship co-ordinator will be Richard Barnard.

## **Article 2 – Jurisdiction**

The championship will be held under the General Regulations of the Motor Sports Association (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA), these Championship Regulations and any written instruction issued.

## **Article 3 – Eligibility**

The Championship will be open to fully paid up members of West Cumbria Motorsport Club Ltd **only**

## **Article 4 – Registration**

The registration fee is £15 per driver and is non refundable. (Registration fee does not include club membership)

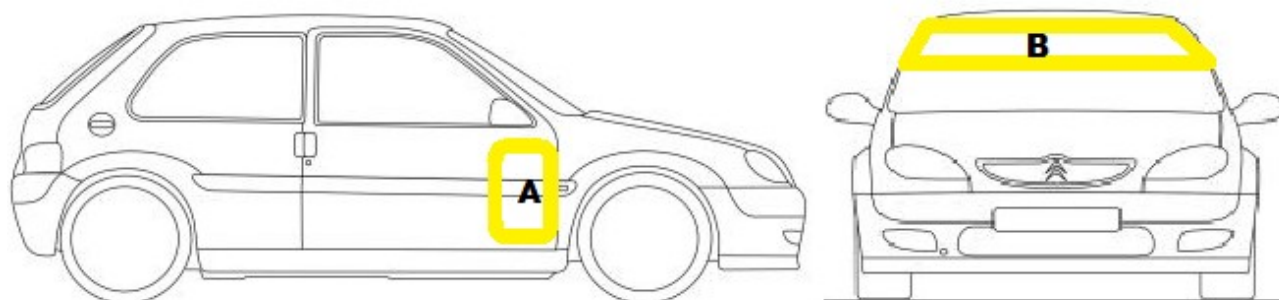
Crews are encourage to remain together for the whole season, however registration remains with the driver.

Registration can be done by completing the form at the end of these regulations and returning to: Mr R Barnard, Moss House, Allonby, Cumbria, CA15 6QF along with the full fee via cheque or via paypal to: WCMC@Hotmail.co.uk

Registration will open on publication of these regulations and close at the start of round 2.

30 Entries are available per event. If demand deems necessary the number of registered crews allowed to enter the championship may be capped to a maximum of 30 to enable those registered fair opportunity to enter events.

Competitors must display the Championship decals as specified on every qualifying event. These include panels A (both sides) and B



If Championship decals are not displayed, the competitor be deemed ineligible for the allocation of championship points. 1 set of sponsor decals will be provided with championship registration fee.

Once a competitor has registered for the championship it is not possible to de-register, even if the series decals are removed.

ALL THE ABOVE DECALS MUST BE FIXED IN THE CORRECT POSITION BEFORE THE CAR IS PRESENTED FOR SCRUTINEERING.

Please note that when a registered competitor (driver or passenger) is competing with a non-registered competitor, championship decals must be displayed as above in order to for the registered party to score points

### **Article 5 – Enforcement of regulations**

The championship will be governed by the general rules as set out in these regulations. Any protests must be lodged with the championship co-ordinator who will have the final say on all issues.

### **Article 6 – Vehicle classes and eligibility**

All vehicles complying with MSA Regulations for autotesting will be accepted.

Additionally there will be 3 classes:

FWD Class – For all front wheel drive cars

The RABsport RWD Class – For all rear wheel drive cars

Junior Class – For all competitors under the age of 18 at the start of round 1 with a maximum engine size of 1400cc.

### **Article 7 – Format & Points**

For the main championship overall there will be 4 points scoring rounds, Points will be awarded on each event as such:

Overall championship

- 15 points for 1<sup>st</sup> place, 14 points for 2<sup>nd</sup> place and so on to 1 point for 15<sup>th</sup> place.

Classes

- 10 points for 1<sup>st</sup> place, 9 points for 2<sup>nd</sup> on to 1 point for 10<sup>th</sup> in class

Juniors

- 5 points for 1<sup>st</sup> place 4 points for 2<sup>nd</sup> place on to 1 point for 5<sup>th</sup>

A competitor's best 3 scores will be counted, with the competitor's worst score (or a zero score) being dropped.

At the end of 4 rounds points will be finalised and winners announced.

## **Article 8 – Awards**

All perpetual awards are the property of WCMC and will be retained by the club after the awards ceremony. These trophies will be made available for photographic purposes during the awards ceremony. **AWARD WINNERS MUST BE PRESENT AT THE END OF SEASON AWARDS CEREMONY.** Non appearance may result in forfeiture of relevant awards. Awards not collected at the Awards Ceremony will NOT be posted.

The awards Ceremony will take place alongside WCMC's traditional awards evening.

To qualify for a championship award a competitor must have started at least 3 qualifying events.

### *Overall Awards:*

**1<sup>st</sup> Overall Crew** – The Rally Test Trophy plus replicas and £150 prize money

**2<sup>nd</sup> Overall Crew** – The 2<sup>nd</sup> place trophy plus £100 prize money

**3<sup>rd</sup> Overall Crew** – The 3<sup>rd</sup> place Trophy plus £50 prize money

### *Class Awards:*

**FWD Class - 1<sup>st</sup> FWD Crew** – A Trophy plus £50 prize money

**RABsport RWD Class - 1<sup>st</sup> RWD Crew** – A Trophy plus £50 prize money

**1<sup>st</sup> Junior** – A Trophy plus a prize package of a free of charge registration and entry to all events on the 2021 Rally Test Championship.

Those Competitors receiving an overall award are not eligible for a class award in addition.

## **Article 9 – Events**

The championship will include the following events:

Round 1 – 26<sup>th</sup> April – Mixed – Oldside speedway, Workington

Round 2 – 19<sup>th</sup> July – Mixed - Oldside speedway, Workington

Round 3 – 20<sup>th</sup> Sept – Mixed – Oldside Speedway, Workington

Round 4 – 25<sup>th</sup> October – Mixed – Oldside Speedway, Workington

### **Dates may be subject to change at landowners request**

Championship registered competitors will receive priority entry on all events over non championship registered crews.

## **Article 10 – Technical Regulations**

In addition to the Motorsport UK Technical regulations for autotesting, and in the interest of promoting the appearance of the championship all crews must comply with the following:

- All cars must be presented to scrutineering in a clean and tidy condition
- All cars must have no leaks where a hazardous liquid is spilling out.
- All cars must be in 'complete' condition. This means all bumpers, body panels, lights or light blanks must be fitted securely, in good condition and not have any holes or gaps larger than 40mm cut into them for cooling. In the interest of clarity this means all competitors must run with lights or blanks fitted and no empty gaps.
- any car running with damage, is allowed to attempt temporary repairs in service to keep the car running. If a panel is lost it must be refitted before they can start the next test.
